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From the Principal's Desk

It gives me immense pleasure that the Annual News Letter of Goalpara College Annals will be published for the year 2020-21. The history of medicine and health reflects that the world witnessed in the past series of pandemics such as Spanish flue etc. Since the last part of 2019, once again mankind witnessed one of the deadliest pandemics in human history in the form of Covid-19. The pandemic has devastated almost every sphere of life. Health, economy and all societal rubrics were badly affected; thousands including children lost their lives; millions lost their livelihood and millions of jobless marginalisedlabours had to migrate thousands of kilometres on foot.

One of the most devastated sectors was education. Like all other educational institutions, we were not prepared for such a traumatic situation. Alienated students, away from their classrooms and far from the peers, had to confine themselves within their homes. During this challenging period Goalpara College took series of initiatives so that academic progress of students could go on unabated. In the initial period of the pandemic, Goalpara College teachers and researchers took measures for preparing sanitiser in college laboratories and distributed in Civil Hospital, DC Office, SP Office, banks and among other essential service personnel. We campaigned for creating awareness among people regarding Covid-appropriate behaviour. Teaching and learning continued through online mode by using different apps. Like the second world War, the covid-19 was also a great learning experience and taught humanity to adopt many new things and to change the lifestyle. In pedagogy, now we give much emphasis to online learning apps such as WebEx, Zoom, Google classroom etc. Educational institutions, office activities, banking and so on witnessed a paradigm shift. This huge technological leap towards online learning is a legacy of Covid 19. Goalpara College organised good number of webinars inviting experts from abroad. Along with scientists, scholars and experts from different parts of the country, we invited men of letters from different parts of the world. People across the globe accompanied us in our academic voyage. Students counselling by teachers, doctors and many different experts were part of our series of initiatives taken by a higher educational institution like ours to fight the onslaught of Covid-19.

She spoke about Siddha Medicine System and the advancement in the same and its relevance in the current pandemic situation thus facilitating our students to understand the gradual change in the medicine system as a

He introduced us to the concept of GMO and discussed on all GMO related stigmas. 
Anidst Covid-19 Lockdown, on the occasion of Van Mahotsav, 2020 an online essay competition was held by Goalpara College.


