

1. Mega plantation drive at Adopted village:

Volunteers and Programme officer of NSS Goalpara College planted more than 150 samplings (Phyllanthus emblica, Pongamia pinnata, Delonix regia, Mesua ferrea, Caesalpinia pulcherrima etc.) in differentparts of Kuruabhasa village of Goalpara (the adopted village) on 3rd August 2021. The saplings were protected through creating net fencing with bamboo pole.



2. Global Hand washing Campaign at Adopted village:

Ten volunteers of NSS, Goalpara College Unit visited the different households of adopted village (Kuruabhasa, Goalpara) to disseminate the knowledge of hand washing and health hygiene as a part of Global hand washing campaign on 2nd November 2021.



3. ODF Plus campaign at Goroimari village:

Volunteers of Goalpara College NSS unit were engaged in the survey works at Goroimari village of Goalpara district in connection to the ODF Plus campaign from 12th November 2021. It was part of the intensive state wide integrated campaign on ODF-Plus & Covid 19 with focus on the aspirational districts. A total of 100 households were surveyed with various parameters like source of earning, qualification, presence of latrine, type of latrine, source of drinking water etc.



4. Review meeting of NSS, Goalpara College Unit:

8. Survey on Feacal Sludge and Septage Management

A seven days survey on Feacal Sludge and Septage Management (FSSM) was conducted by seven selected volunteers of Goalpara College NSS Unit in various locations of Goalpara district. The survey was organized jointly by Women Development Centre and Goalpara Municipality Board in association with NSS, Goalpara College Unit. Volunteers were trained initially by the resource persons and survey was conducted from 29th to 30th December 2021 and from 3rd to 7th January 2022 in 350 households randomly under the guidance of two Community mobilizers.



9. Cleanliness drive at Goalpara College campus

A cleanliness drive was done in the Goalpara College campus by the volunteers of Goalpara College NSS Unit on 11th January 2022.
