GOALPARA, Feb 22: The Physics Department Alumni Association of Goalpara College along with the Physical Society of the college organised the first Kamaleswar Goswami Memorial Lecture in the college premises on Monday.

Dr Goswami, who was a renowned nuclear physicist, was the founder head of the Physics department of Goalpara College. Former head of the Physics department of the college and former principal of Chaygaon College, Prof Arun Chandra Sarma delivered the lecture on the topic 'Earthquake: Man's scientific quest.'

Delivering his speech in the meeting of around 150 people, presided over by the president of the alumni association Dr Ranjit Choudhury, Prof Sarma gave a beautiful presentation of the plate-tectonic theory and described how the shifting movement of the plates causes the earthquake.
